COMPUTER-AIDED CHINESE READING & WRITING

COMPUTER-AIDED CHINESE READING & WRITING is designed to train students in a basic knowledge of the Chinese writing system. In this course, students will learn how to read and write and type Chinese Chinese characters using Microsoft Chinese Word on the basis of their existing knowledge of the language whether more basic or more advanced.

It will create a comfort level in the knowledge of the standard Putonghua with an emphasis on listening, speaking and communicating when traveling in China and other Chinese speaking regions.

It is intended to prepare students to understand a basic knowledge of Chinese Writing and intermediate Chinese Conversation beyond the basic level. Students can practice communicating in Chinese in situations that are typical when traveling, attending lectures and meetings, or negotiating contracts in Chinese speaking countries.
